● FLOW CHURCH PROJECT

A local church, Flow of the Spirit Church, located in Asheville, Alabama was having a very successful summer kid's crusade when disaster struck. After a night of ministering to close to 1,000 children (and 31 of them accepting Christ as their Lord), a fire broke out and destroyed the entire church building. Much of the church was new construction and the congregation was growing. Sunday services have grown to close to 600, with about 25% in the children and youth. The future of Flow Church is very bright and this fire is a minor setback.



A call went out, and SGO was asked to help renovate an empty commercial building with approximately 8,000 sq. feet right down the highway from their property. A request for volunteers went out and more than 30 men answered the call. New walls were laid out, materials were brought in, walls were erected, electrical pulled and sheetrock hung. Over the next few days, the walls will be finished, painted and doors hung. We will then lay new floors and be ready to minister to children again.

SGO is thankful for the opportunity to support and help Flow Church. We are excited about their future and their ministry to children and youth. The fire was meant for evil, but we believe it will create good.

● ADULLAM HOUSE PROJECT

The Adullam House children's home is a special place for all who are involved with SGO. This home loves the almost 50 children at the home, and cares for them in an incredible way. All these children have parents who are incarcerated and unable to care for their children, but do desire they be raised in a Godly home.



Adullam House is a home where these children can find their purpose in life and grow up to be productive and Godly men and women.

Recently, a piece of property with a mobile home was purchased next to the home, and was in need of repair and renovation. SGO has taken on this project and the first trip was a great success! We expect to go back two more times to complete the needed repairs. This mobile home will be used for staff accommodations.

● HANDICAP RAMPS

Over the past few weeks, we have had three different requests to help provide homes with wheelchair ramps. It is difficult for many handicapped people to do simple tasks, like going to the store, because it is very difficult, if not impossible, for them to get out of their home. SGO is always glad to look at the need and help the handicapped when they need help.



The three ramps that have been built were for various people. One of the ramps was for one of our first responder paramedics who was involved in an auto accident, and was wheelchair-bound for a couple of months. Another ramp was for a little 7 year old girl with health issues that created a problem for her getting in and out of her home because of the steps. The third ramp was for a man in Marshall County who fell off a roof while working and broke both of his ankles. His recovery will take some time, and he lived in a mobile home with steps.

SGO was blessed to meet and help all these people who were in need. Projects like these, and many more, is what SGO is all about. We desire to share the love of Christ whenever and wherever we have the opportunity.
